By car from the South

M40 exit at junction 10. Join A43 signposted to Northampton. Silverstone is signposted from the A43

By car from the North

M1 exit at junction 15a. Follow signs for the A43 to Oxford. Silverstone is signposted from the A43

Satellite Navigation

If you are driving a vehicle with Satellite Navigation, simply enter the postcode or in Destination Input (in Porsche vehicles) enter POI: Silverstone Circuit or postcode: NN12 8TN

By train

The most convenient stations for access to Silverstone Circuit are Northampton and Milton Keynes Central. Trains from London leave from Euston approximately every 30 minutes. There is a taxi rank immediately outside Northampton and Milton Keynes Central.


Arrival at Silverstone Circuit

On arrival at Silverstone Circuit follow the signs to West 10. Once at West 10, security will direct you.

Once through the gate take the right turn and follow the perimeter road for one mile around the circuit, following the signs to the Porsche Experience On arrival parking is available at the front of the building. Overflow parking is available in the car park on the right hand side as you enter the main parking area.

Your Vehicle

If you are participating in your own vehicle, please ensure your vehicle is insured, holds a valid MOT and is in a roadworthy condition. Please pay particular attention to the tyre tread depth, that your windscreen is clean and crack free and that all external lights are operational.

Insurance requirements

Our insurance requirements should have been explained to you during the booking process. As a reminder, participants will be required to meet the criteria below.

- Participants must hold a full, valid Driving Licence to drive a car upon public highways in the UK.
- To be eligible to drive any of the Turbo models, you must be aged 21 or over.
- To be eligible to drive any of the GT models, you must be aged 25 or over.
- Drivers over the age of 80 should contact the team to discuss possible arrangements.
- You must be medically fit and not have any medical conditions which will affect your ability to drive.

The Straights

A safe and controlled environment to fully explore how a Porsche accelerates and stops. Kick Plate

A moveable metal plate set flush with the road surface designed to be triggered remotely as a car travels over it, thereby generating the effect of a loss of rear wheel traction.

Ice Hill



Simulating sheet ice with computercontrolled water jets, this area allows drivers to explore general car control and handling characteristics.

Off-Road

With 45% declines and ascents, rough terrain and unfeasible side slopes designed to challenge even the most focused 4x4s.



Conditions of Participation

In agreeing today to be a passenger in and/or drive any of the vehicles made available by Porsche Cars Great Britain Limited ("Porsche") for driving demonstration purposes, whether on road or track (including the Porsche Experience Centre track operated by Porsche, and/or to drive my own vehicle on the Porsche Experience Centre track operated by Porsche and/or the Silverstone track operated by Silverstone Circuits Limited (collectively "Tracks"), I agree that:

- I hold a valid full UK Driving Licence to drive a vehicle upon public highways; OR I hold a valid full foreign Driving Licence and I am entitled to drive a vehicle upon public highways in the UK under such licence.
- I am medically fit enough to participate and I declare that my eyesight is up to the standard required of a road driving test. I am not suffering from any disability which is likely adversely to affect my ability to control a vehicle. I am not under the influence of alcohol, and have not taken any form of medication, drugs or other substance, and know of no other reason or factor, which will or may impair my driving abilities or restrict me from participating in the Porsche Driving Experience.
- I agree that I will not participate in any activities unless I have first received a drivers briefing, following which I will abstain from participating should I not agree or understand the inherent risks involved. I will follow the instructions given to me by Porsche, its employees, agents and/or contractors whilst the vehicle is in my possession.

If I have chosen to drive my own vehicle on one or more of the Tracks, I agree that:

- ✓ The vehicle (i) has a current MOT, (ii) is fully taxed, (iii) is roadworthy, (iv) has not less than the minimum tyre tread depths recommended by the tyre manufacturer, (v) has clean and crack-free windscreen and windows for excellent visibility, and (vi) has fully operational external lights.
- ✓ If required for safety or legal reasons, Porsche, its employees, agents and/or contractors have the right to reject any vehicle for participation at the Tracks, and require any vehicle to leave the Tracks and/or permanently retire from activities at the Tracks at any time, without paying me compensation.

Where Porsche organises insurance of the vehicles, I accept that I owe Porsche and its insurer a duty of utmost good faith which includes an obligation to let Porsche, its employees, agents and/or contractors know of anything that will or may affect the validity or continuity of Porsche's insurance policy. I promise that I have disclosed any such matter or fact already known to me (and will disclose any such matter or fact that becomes known to me). I understand that I may not be covered by Porsche's insurance if I have not disclosed such matter or fact, or if any statements or promises I make are untrue or incomplete.

I understand that Porsche will be responsible for (i) any personal injury I suffer as a result of its own negligence or the negligence of its employees, agents or contractors and also for (ii) any loss or damage (not including any purely financial or business loss, such as loss of revenue, loss of profit or loss of opportunity) I suffer that is caused by Porsche's breach of contract, or breach of legal duty of care, where such loss or damage is reasonably foreseeable. Loss or damage is "reasonably foreseeable" if, at the time Porsche and I entered into this relationship, such loss or damage was contemplated by us. I accept that Porsche will not be responsible for any other loss or damage arising from my participation in the Porsche Driving Experience, whether as a passenger or as a driver.

I accept that if, in connection with my participation in the Porsche Driving Experience, any loss or damage is suffered by Porsche, its employees, agents and/or contractors, or by any third party, as a result of my negligence or my breach of any of the above terms, then I shall be responsible for (i) all losses, damages or expenses suffered by Porsche, its employees, agents and/or contractors and (ii) if Porsche organises insurance of the vehicles, any excess on any insurance policy maintained by Porsche in respect of the vehicle liability, up to a maximum of five hundred pounds (GBP £500) if I am aged 21 years or older and have held my driving licence for more than two years or one thousand pounds (GBP £1,000) if I am aged under 21 years and/or have held by driving licence for less than two years.


